This Week's Highlights

Week 10 Plans for Junior Secondary Students

Monday: All students will attend normal timetabled classes.

Tuesday: Rewards Day for invited students in Years 7 to 9.

Year 7 and Year 8 Rewards Day - students to gather on the administration lawn at 8.50am. Buses will not wait for late students. Students must wear their college uniform and bring a water bottle, hat and sunscreen. They may purchase food at the venue if they prefer.

Year 9 Rewards Day - students meet in the MPS for Period 1. They will depart for Cooloom Aqua Park at 10.00am. Students must wear their college uniform and bring a water bottle, hat and sunscreen. They are reminded to wear appropriate swimwear that is modest and suitable for a school activity. A rash shirt with sleeves or water shirt is compulsory for sun safety. Students may purchase food at the venue cafe.

Students who have not been invited to Rewards Day - will be supervised by teachers at the College for the duration of the day. Students are to meet under S Block at 8.50am.

Wednesday: Students to meet under S Block to be organised into groups for the day. In the afternoon, they can enjoy inflatables at the Pool. Consent has been sent via QParents. Students must attend school for the entire day to participate in this activity. Wristbands will be distributed prior to the event. Students who do not wish to swim will be supervised back at school.

Recommended System Requirements for BYO (Bring Your Own) Devices

The IT department has updated the Recommended System Requirements for BYOx devices for the coming year. It can be found on the school website here. Windows 11 devices are advised, support for Windows 10 will be ending at some stage depending on the Microsoft support arrangements. Chromebooks, iPads, Androids and Co-Pilot+ PCs are not acceptable devices at this College. See the website for more information.

e-Bikes and Personal Mobility Devices

If you are considering purchasing your child a personal mobility device or e-bike, please note the following Queensland rules. From 2026 any suspected non-complaint device at school will be referred to our school-based police officer for follow up.

Personal mobility devices can include:

- e-scooters, e-skateboards or self-balancing single wheeled devices (like e-unicycles and e-boards).

To ride a personal mobility device, you must be either:

- at least 16 years **OR** at least 12 years and supervised by an adult while riding the device.

Children under 12 years of age must not ride personal mobility devices.

e-Bikes:

- Pedals must be the primary source of power, motor assistance cannot go beyond 25km/hr, maximum motor output 250 watts and must have a compliance sticker.
