

Gradual Release - Teaching Phases:

	Teacher:	Student:	How do I teach this?
UDO: Watch, Listen and Learn.	 Establish purpose. (What? Why? How?) Clear and explicit instructions. Modelling. Give examples and deconstruct. Question student for understanding. 	 Active listening. Take notes. Watch and observe. Ask and answer questions. Be ready to learn. (Resources ready and available) 	 Explicit instruction. Think alouds. Multiple models. (Verbal and visual) Build on prior knowledge. Examples and non-examples. Practical demonstration/ How-to videos.
WE DO: Practice with guidance.	 Questions, prompts and cues. Model and guide the process. On the spot differentiation. Clarify, encourage, direct or re-direct. Rove and assist. 	 Active engagement. Practice with guidance. Work as a team and help each other. Clarify and respond to questions. Add ideas and thinking. 	 Build on prior knowledge. Questioning. Graphic organisers. Scaffolds. Brainstorming and discussion. Structured practice. Think-Pair-Share. Group work. Joint construction. Academic games.

Gradual Release – Learning Phases:

	Teacher:	Student:	How do I teach this?
YOU DO TOGETHER: Work with peers.	 Clarify task. Provide scaffold and adjust as required. Question for understanding. Rove and facilitate interactions. Monitor, encourage and refocus. 	 Follow task instructions. Practice skills. Ask questions. Engage in task, active listening. Collaborate respectfully. 	Cooperative learning may include: Inquiry-based learning. Digital interactive activities. Expert groups. Jigsaw. Rotation stations. Group investigation. Academic games. Group research.
YOU DO ALONE: Work independently.	 Set conditions for learning. (What? Why? How?) Provide differentiation. Monitor progress and engagement. Provide additional feedback. Set marker/ time frame for progress. 	 Attempt set work and produce an outcome. Monitor own time. Clarify by asking questions. Utilise available resources and exemplars. Work independently. 	Knowledge application tasks may include: Scaffolds. Graphic organiser. Exemplars. Learning journals. Problem solving. Inquiry-based learning.
