District and Regional Sport Trials (Secondary Students)

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

As a student enrolled in a Coastal District-affiliated school, you are invited to participate in the 2025 school representative sport pathway. This pathway begins with trialling at either the Coastal District or Regional level, offering the opportunity to progress to Sunshine Coast Regional, State, and National Championships if successful.

Participation in this pathway requires a two-step process:

1. Nominate through Kawana Waters State College – This ensures you receive all relevant information and access to the registration process.
2. Register with Coastal District or Sunshine Coast Region – Details will be provided upon confirmation of your nomination.

Please be aware of the following key points:

- Nomination Deadlines: **The due date for nominations is Friday, 7 February 2025.** Late nominations may limit your opportunity to participate in District or Regional trials.
- School-Based Selection: Some sports may require a school-based selection process due to limited availability. As an example, Football, Futsal and Surfing will be determined by our excellence program coordinators.
- Eligibility: These trials are competitive events, designed for students who are both competent and experienced in their chosen sport and age group.
