


• Contribute 25% of final result for all General Subjects except General Maths and Science subjects. These will contribute 50% of final result


Entrance



- Primary mechanism used nationally to compare students across Australia when applying for Tertiary admission
- ATAR is not a grade, it is a rank
- Indicates a students' position relative to other students
- 2000 point scale from 99.95 down to 0.00 (increments of 0.05)
- ATAR below 30 will not be reported


