Our Vision

Kawana Waters State College is committed to ensuring each child reaches their full potential. Our philosophy is closely aligned to Education Queensland's vision, in that we optimise '...every student's opportunity to achieve their potential'. Our vision for students who aspire to develop their football abilities is that they are provided with the right environment of coaching in order to pick up the necessary skills to be a successful footballer in the future.











What is the Kawana Waters Junior Football Program?

This Program is designed to provide school-based football development opportunities for talented and motivated footballers. Junior Football Program participants will participate in a range of football and futsal skills development sessions with other students of similar ability during their final two years of primary school.

The aim of the Junior Football Program is to provide footballers with targeted training to improve their technical ability. These sessions will be focused on skill acquisition in the four core skills; first touch, running with the ball, striking the ball and 1 v 1. These sessions focus on ball mastery and promote good football habits in students. Throughout the sessions, students will be challenged and extended in their personal football development.

Successful applicants will participate in football/futsal sessions one day a week from 7:00am-8:00am in term 2 and 3 on the secondary campus of Kawana Waters State College. These sessions aim to compliment students' current training and prepare them for entry into the high school Football Excellence Program at our college.

Junior Football Program participants may also be invited to participate in a range of football opportunities that occur at Kawana Waters State College Secondary Campus throughout the year.

Cost:

The program is designed to engage students with high quality coaches in a high quality training environment. To cover associated costs of coaching and equipment an **\$100** fee will be charged for the program. This cost will include a training shirt for use during the sessions. This fee is required prior to students commencing the program.

Identification of Students

The process for identifying students who are eligible for the Junior Football Program is illustrated below.

Step One — Identification

An application form is completed and submitted. This includes a detailed description of the student's football experience to date.

Step Two — Selection

Application and supporting documentation will determine selection of students eligible for the Junior Football Program in the upcoming school year. Applicants will be notified via email and the successful applicants of the Junior Football Program will be announced in Term 1.

Step Three — Monitoring

Kawana Waters State College Football Excellence Coaches will monitor students in the Junior Football Program to assist students gaining entry to our Football Program of Excellence (FEX) in Year 7. It is envisaged that Junior Football Program students will join our FEX Program in Years 7-12. Please note that all JFP students must apply and trial for the secondary campus Football Program of Excellence in year 7 and are not guaranteed automatic entry.
